3. Requirements for participation

- Holder of World Taekwondo Global License.
- Successfully passed **Level I Classifier (National)** Certification Course.
- If you did not attend **Level I Classifier** course before, you can register now both **Level I** and **Level II Classifier** certification courses.

4. Registration process

- Registration through GMS - <https://worldtkd.simplycompete.com/login>. (Infographics attached for details)
- Participants can make registration at the same time when registering for **Level I Classifier (National)** Certification Course.

5. Registration Fees

- **ONLY Level II Classifier (International K40)** certification course **300 US\$**.
- **Both Level I Classifier (National) and Level II Classifier (International K40)** Certification courses **500 US\$ (special rate, done through offline payment bank transfer)**.

6. Payment method

Option 1: Online Payment Instruction

- If applying for this course **ONLY**, applicant can pay directly online by credit/debit card at the time of registration.
- If the applicant wishes to pay online at a later time but before the deadline, applicant can log in back at any time to their own personal "**GMS profile**", go to "**Courses**", find the course and click on "**PAY**" button to pay online by credit/debit card.

7. Certification & Training

- Level II course is **PRACTICAL** in nature.
- Who have successfully passed the course (at least **70%**) will be granted World Para Taekwondo **Level II TRAINEE** certificate issued online through GMS.
- **Level II Classifier Trainee (International K40)** must successfully pass **TWO** international classification evaluations as a trainee with a score of at least **70%** by a Senior International Classifiers & approval of Head of Classification.
- Evaluation will occur at a minimum of two **(2) practicums** and a minimum of twenty **(20) K40 athletes**.
- Depending on your background, qualifications and performance you will then be certified as either an International **MEDICAL** Classifier or International **TECHNICAL** Classifier.
- If you fail any of the evaluations as a **Level II classifier trainee**, you will be given a **third chance** to be re-evaluated. If you fail your third evaluation you must retake **Level II Course**.
- Once you pass your Level II training & practicum successfully, you will receive a **Level II (International K40)** certificate.

8. Learning Outcomes

- Understand IPC Classification Code and WT Para Taekwondo rules.
- Interpretation of the Medical Diagnostic Form (MDF).
- Classifier room set up and using classifier tools
- Complete K40 Athlete assessment and evaluation.
- Place athletes in the correct K40 Sport Class.
- Understand the difference between a Sport Class and a Sport Class Status
- Protest procedures, risk management and the impact of misrepresentation.
- Differentiate between misrepresentation and non-cooperation of an Athlete
- Be familiar with all K40 forms.
- Complete Athlete Observations in Competition.
- Complete classifiers notes including observation assessment.

9. Failure to Pass the Examination

- Candidates who do not successfully pass the practical examination will be allowed to attend **ONLY** the next available course free of charge

10. Flights & accommodation

- Candidates who are attending the physical courses will have to arrange their own flights and accommodation.
- For those who successfully pass their practical exam may be allowed to attend as a trainee (practicum). This will depend on their performance, as well as the number of participants and the number of registered athletes for classification.
